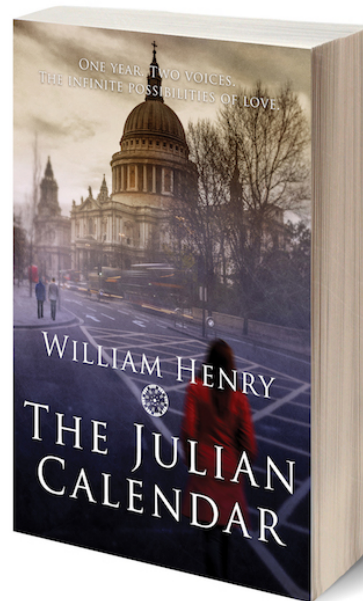
Simon Hertnon (simonhertnon.com) launches his fiction career as **William Henry** with this captivating love story.
